I will be required to maintain a GPA of at least 2.7 current following the Winter 2021  
term. Failure to do so will cause the award to be revoked.
5. I will be required to submit a written commentary when I return of at least 500 words on  
the highlights of my experience abroad and how the Award and experience as a whole  
have affected me, my future plans, and/or my goals.
6. I will be required to participate in an Education Abroad Program Pre-Departure  
session, complete the Education Abroad Online Pre-Departure Course, register for  
the UGo Off-Campus Travel Registry and complete any other required Risk  
Management tasks. The award payment will not be made under any circumstances  
until these tasks are completed.
7. Copies of my boarding passes or other proof of travel will need to be submitted to  
Education Abroad upon my return. Failure to do so will require me to repay the  
award in full and my University of Alberta registration privileges may be revoked.

8. The University of Alberta reserves the right to cancel any off-campus activity or travel if it believes the risks are unacceptable or unwarranted and cannot be reasonably managed. No award under any circumstances will be produced until study abroad has been authorized by the University of Alberta. The award funding cannot be used for travel to a country or region with a Global Affairs Canada advisory of Avoid Non-Essential Travel or Avoid All Travel unless approved by the University.
9. The award is subject to the University of Alberta's travel policies and exceptions relating to COVID-19. If travel is restricted due to COVID-19, or travel approval is not received for the 2021-2022 academic year, the Award will be forfeited and cannot be carried forward to a future academic year.
10. The Award funding will be disbursed no sooner than two weeks prior to your program.
